● **Biological Resources**

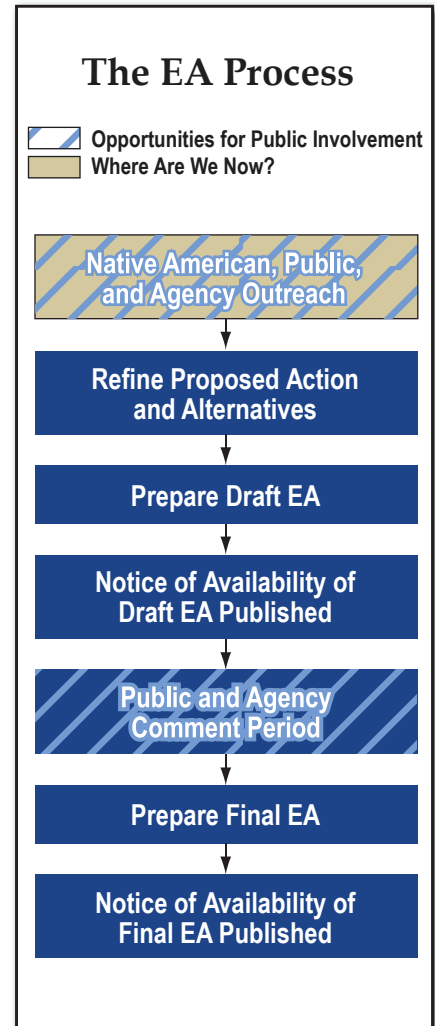
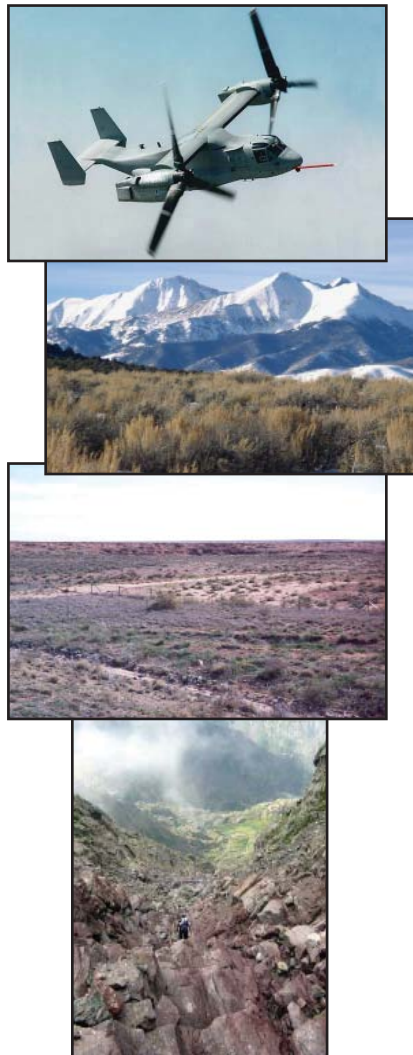
Terrestrial, Wetland, and Freshwater aquatic Communities, Threatened and Endangered, and Special Status Species.
